What is Zonta?

ZONTA INTERNATIONAL IS A GLOBAL ORGANISATION OF EXECUTIVES AND PROFESSIONALS WORKING TOGETHER TO ADVANCE THE STATUS OF WOMEN WORLDWIDE THROUGH SERVICE AND ADVOCACY.

The aims of Zontians around the world are to:

- advocate effectively on women's issues
- provide mission-focused service, locally and globally, in order to improve women's legal rights, health, education and economic status, and to prevent violence against women
- combine service with advocacy to enhance our effectiveness.

Zonta International was founded in 1919 in Buffalo, New York State, USA. The name 'Zonta' is derived from a Lakota Sioux Indian word meaning 'honest and trustworthy'.

Worldwide there are over 33 000 members in 67 countries.

About Perth Northern Suburbs

The Zonta Club of Perth Northern Suburbs Inc. was chartered on 22 June 1981. Service Projects

Locally we support groups and programs that focus on issues affecting the lives of women, such as:

- a women's refuge
- holiday camps for victims of domestic violence
- educational awards for young and mature women
- making cushions for breast surgery after-care
- assembly of kits to enable clean birthing facilities for women in remote regions of the world.

Global programs and projects we support include:

- **Amelia Earhart Fellowship Awards**—financial assistance to women pursuing graduate degrees in aerospace-related science and engineering
- **Young Women in Public Affairs Awards**—encourage young women to engage in public service
- **Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarships**—financial assistance to women pursuing undergraduate degrees in business management
- **Zonta International Service Fund**—sustainable self-help programs, technical and other assistance for women in developing nations
- **ZISVAW Fund (Zonta International Strategies to Prevent Violence against Women)**—prevention, awareness and education, and innovative solutions to eliminate abuse against women and children

Approximately one-third of funds we raise are directed to the Zonta International Foundation.
